2027–2028 Session Call for applications open

SEPTEMBER 15 – NOVEMBER 16, 2026 (23:59 FRENCH TIME / GMT +1).

Requirements

Candidates must :

- Be under 65 years old at the beginning of their contract with the IHEAL.
- Hold a Ph.D. degree (obtained at least 5 years ago).
- Be a teacher at the university level or a researcher at a foreign research organization.

Number of positions :

- First semester: Three candidates will be recruited (4 months: 01/09/2027 – 17/12/2027).
 - Second semester: Three candidates will be recruited (3 months: 03/01/2028 – 31/03/2028).
 - Full academic year: One candidate (9 months: 01/09/2027 – 31/05/2028).
- This fellowship allows the invited scholar to immerse themselves in the academic life of the University.
 - Teaching load: four courses (24 hours each).
 - The scholar will also supervise students' research writing in French.

Teaching load :

- One-semester fellowships: Two courses per semester (24 hours each).
- Academic-year fellowship: Four courses (24 hours each).

Salary & benefits:

- Visiting scholars receive a monthly salary corresponding to the specific index for university professors in France.
- Important: IHEAL does not provide financial aid for travel or accommodation expenses.

Course content:

- The subject must align with the scholar's field of expertise.
- Proposed courses may be adapted according to IHEAL's needs.
- Courses may be taught in Spanish, English, or French.
- Eligible fields: Anthropology, Contemporary History (20th & 21st centuries), Economics, Geography, Political Science, Sociology.

Other academic activities:

- Invited scholars may also collaborate with other departments of Sorbonne Nouvelle University, as well as with French and European institutions partnered with the IHEAL.

2. Send online the following documents (PDF only) :

- Cover letter.
- Official affiliation letter from the applicant's current university (for the current academic year).
- Curriculum Vitae (max. 5 pages), including:
 - University credentials (excluding short-term seminars or programs of less than one year).
 - Professional experience.
 - Research and teaching experience.
 - Administrative responsibilities and/or participation in research initiatives.
 - Contributions to national and international colloquia.
 - List of publications (organized as follows: books; articles in national and international journals; research reports; symposium proceedings; peer-reviewed book reviews).
 - All information must be listed chronologically (most recent first).
- Two letters of recommendation (signed and stamped by the institution).
- Copy of Ph.D. degree.
- Course proposals :
 - For one-semester fellowships (3–4 months): three course descriptions (max. 2 pages each), including objectives and proposed syllabus.
 - For one academic year (9 months): five course descriptions (max. 2 pages each).
 - Each course description must specify the teaching language (English, Spanish, or French) and be written in that language.
- Copy of a valid passport.

- Applications may be written in French, Spanish, or English.
- Each application will be reviewed by one IHEAL member and one external scholar.

Requirements

Candidates must :

- Be under 65 years old at the beginning of their contract with the IHEAL.
- Hold a Ph.D. degree (obtained at least 5 years ago).
- Be a teacher at the university level or a researcher at a foreign research organization.

Duration and Salary

- The candidates will be recruited for two months (from the first to the last day of the month: September-October; October-November; February-March; March-April; April-May).
- Visiting scholars will receive a monthly salary which corresponds to a specific index for University professors in France.

Expenses

- The IHEAL does not provide financial aid for travel or accommodation expenses.

Activities and Commitments

- During their stay, researchers will be invited to participate in IHEAL-CREDA research activities and to work in close collaboration with IHEAL-CREDA professors.
- During these two months, they will have to write an article. An intermediate version of which will be published on the IHEAL website.

Disciplines

- The IHEAL receives applications in the following areas: Anthropology, Contemporary History (XXth & XXIst centuries), Economics, Geography, Political Science, Sociology.

Collaborations

- Invited scholars can perform scientific and academic activities in the other Departments of the Sorbonne Nouvelle University, or any of the French and European Institutions with which the IHEAL collaborates upon requests.

2. Send online the following documents (PDF only) :

- A cover letter.
- A detailed presentation of the collaborations envisaged at IHEAL-CREDA and beyond (maximum 1000 words).
- An official letter stating the affiliation of the candidate to her or his university for the current year.
- A brief résumé (5 pages max) including the following information: the candidate's university credentials (excluding seminars and programs that were less than a year-long); Professional experience; Research and experience as a Professor; Experience in administrative activities and/or participation in research initiatives; Contribution to national or international colloquies. Finally, the résumé must include a list of the candidate's published works (classified first by books, then articles in national and international reviews, research reports, symposium summaries and critical reviews of books published in peer-reviewed journals).

All information must be chronologically ordered with the most recent positions and activities listed first.

- Two letters of recommendation with signature and institutional stamp.
- A copy of the candidate's PhD degree.
- An article project (maximum 2000 words). An intermediate version of which will be published on the IHEAL website. A final version may be published in a journal, committing to mention that this article was written with the support of IHEAL-CREDA.
- A copy of your valid passport.

Application Deadline

NOVEMBER 16, 2026 – 23:59 (FRENCH TIME / GMT +1).

- Applications can be written either in French, Spanish, Portuguese or English.
- Each application will be evaluated by an IHEAL member and a non-IHEAL researcher or professor.
